TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Article 1

The organization of the Village, including opening and closing dates, venue, prices and authorized public are determined by the organizer and may be modified at his own initiative. The exhibitor is then returned the amount of his deposit or participation. The exhibitor assumes all the risks related to the possible non-realization of the Village and in particular the exclusive charge of the expenses which he will have incurred in anticipation of the Village. In the event that, for major, unforeseeable or economic reasons (such as fire, flood, destruction, accident, fortuitous event, local or national strike, riot, risk of insecurity, storm, terrorist threat, health situation ... at the local, national or international level), the Village can not take place, applications for admission are canceled and the sums available, after payment of the expenses incurred, are distributed among the exhibitors, at prorated amounts paid by each of them. The exhibitor entrusts the organizer with the task of assessing whether the Village should be interrupted or evacuated in the event of a threat to the safety of the public and undertakes not to complain to him at a later date. The exhibitor undertakes to respect and to enforce the prescriptions of the technical file which will be given to him.

Article 2 - Conditions of participation

In accordance with the provisions relating to commercial events, an exhibitor may neither present products that do not comply with French regulations, except products intended for foreign markets, nor carry out a deceptive or unfair advertisement. The offer presented by the exhibitors must be in accordance with the public order and the laws in force. As such, exhibitors are formally prohibited from exhibiting illicit products or from illicit activities. It is also forbidden for any person not authorized by law to offer services or products related to regulated activities. Exhibitors who violate these provisions may be subject to prosecution without prejudice to measures that may be taken by the organizer to stop the infringement. Exhibitors assume full responsibility for their products vis-à-vis third parties, the responsibility of the organizer can not, in any way, be engaged.

Article 3 - Application to participate

Anyone wishing to exhibit address to the organizer a request to participate. Unless the organizer refuses the requested participation, the sending of this request for

participation constitutes a firm and irrevocable commitment to pay the full price of the organization's services and ancillary costs.

Article 4 - Withdrawal or resignation

In the event of withdrawal or non-use of the exhibition space for any reason whatsoever, sums paid and / or remaining due partially or totally, in respect of the organizational services and ancillary costs, shall be acquired by the organizer even if another exhibitor benefits from the exhibition space. In the event that an exhibitor, for any reason, does not occupy his exhibition space 24 hours before the opening of the Village, he is considered to have resigned.

Article 5 - Terms of payment

The payment of the organizational service and ancillary costs is done according to the deadlines and according to the modalities determined by the organizer. For any late application for participation, the first payment is equal to the amounts already due at the date of the application for participation.

Article 6 - Stand construction

The organizer undertakes to make available to the exhibitor the stand rented, installed and assembled before the opening date of the event until the closing of the event. For its part, the exhibitor undertakes to take possession of the rented premises that will be indicated to him by the organizer within the time limits that will be specified before the start of the event. Stands must be impeccable. The packaging, the objects having no connection with the decoration of the stand must be out of sight of the visitors. The installation of exhibition spaces is designed according to the general plan established by the organizer. The organizer determines the display modalities, the conditions of use of all sound, light or audiovisual processes, as well as the conditions under which any promotional operation or animation can be organized within the Village. The organizer gives and leases the following services to the exhibitor who accepts them. The hiring includes the assembly, the maintenance and the dismantling of the stand, the right of site, the permanence of day and the guarding of night, the removal of the external waste, the external decoration. The spaces are delivered empty, the interior is at the expense of the exhibitor. The interior decoration must be attractive and recall the atmosphere of the current event. It is forbidden to drill and screw into

partitions and internal or external doors. Any degradation will result in penalties. The organizers reserve the right to remove or modify any arrangement that would be detrimental to the overall aestheticism of the event or disturb neighboring exhibitors or visitors. The exhibitor undertakes to respect the safety standards of the decorative and landscaping elements. It is strictly forbidden to manipulate the electrical installations made available to exhibitors.

Article 7 - Plan and deliveries

The organizer establishes the plan of the Village and distributes the locations freely, taking into account, if possible, the wishes expressed by the exhibitor, the nature of the products and / or services it presents, the layout of the space. the exhibition to be installed and, if necessary, the date of registration of the application for participation. The organizer can modify the size and layout of the surfaces requested by the exhibitor. This amendment does not authorize the exhibitor to unilaterally terminate his commitment to participation. The location of the exhibition space allocated to an exhibitor is communicated to him by means of a plan. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that the plan conforms to the layout of the exhibition space. Each exhibitor himself provides for the transport and reception of the goods destined for him. He is obliged to comply with the instructions of the organizer concerning the regulation of the entries and exits of the goods.

Article 8 - Rehabilitation

The organizer declines any responsibility concerning the constructions or installations built by the exhibitors. Exhibitors take the locations in the state in which they find them and must leave them in the same state. Any damage, in particular to the premises and installations in which the Village is located, caused by an exhibitor or by its facilities, equipment or merchandise is the responsibility of this exhibitor.

Article 9 - Liability Insurance of the organizer

Insurance is taken out by the organizer against the pecuniary consequences of his civil liability as an organizer. Exhibitors may ask the organizer to send them an insurance certificate specifying the risks covered, the guarantee limits and the period of cover.

Article 10 - Liability Insurance of the organizer

Insurance is taken out by the organizer against the pecuniary consequences of his civil liability as an organizer. Exhibitors may ask the organizer to send them an insurance certificate specifying the risks covered, the guarantee limits and the period of cover.

Article 11. Exhibitor's Civil Liability Insurance

The exhibitor has the obligation to take out an insurance policy covering the pecuniary consequences of his civil liability as an exhibitor and, in particular, the responsibilities that he is likely to incur against any third party throughout the Village (assembly and dismantling included). This insurance must be taken out with a notoriously solvent company and cover the exhibitor for sufficient amounts. The exhibitor undertakes to communicate this policy to the organizer at the first request of the latter.
