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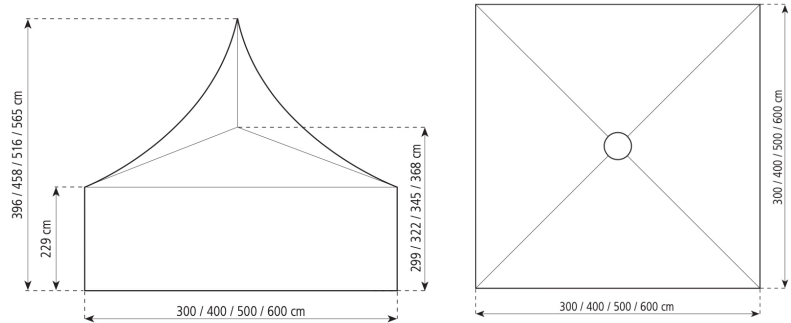

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## **GENERAL REGULATION**

### **Article 1**

The terms of organization of the Village, including opening and closing dates, location, prizes and authorized audiences are determined by the organizer and may be modified at his initiative. The organizer may cancel or postpone the Village if he finds an insufficient number of registrants. The exhibitor will then be refunded the amount of his deposit or participation. The exhibitor assumes all risks related to the possible non-realization of the Village and in particular the exclusive responsibility for the expenses incurred by him in anticipation of the Village. In the event that, for major, unforeseeable or economic reasons (such as fire, flood, destruction, accident, act of God, local or national strike, riot, risk of insecurity, storm, terrorist threat, health situation... at local, national or international level), the Village cannot take place, applications for admission shall be cancelled and the sums available, after payment of expenses incurred, shall be divided among the exhibitors, in proportion to the sums paid by each. The exhibitor confies to the organizer to assess whether the Village must be interrupted or evacuated in the event of a threat to the safety of the public and undertakes not to make any claim against it afterwards. The exhibitor undertakes to respect and ensure respect of the technical file that will be given to him.

### **Article 2 - Conditions of participation**

In application of the provisions relating to commercial events, an exhibitor may neither present products that do not comply with French regulations, except for products intended for foreign markets, nor engage in deceptive or unfair advertising. The offre presented by exhibitors must be in accordance with public order and the laws in force. As such, exhibitors are strictly forbidden to display illegal products or products from illegal activities. It is also forbidden to all persons not authorized by law to offer services or products related to regulated activities. Exhibitors who violate these provisions may be prosecuted without prejudice to the measures that may be taken by the organizer to stop this violation. Exhibitors assume full responsibility for their products with respect to third parties, the responsibility of the organizer can in no way be engaged.

### **Article 3 - Application for participation**

Any person wishing to exhibit shall send the organizer an application for participation. Unless the organizer refuses the requested participation, the sending of this request for participation constitutes a firm and irrevocable commitment to pay the full price of the organization service and related costs.

### **Article 4 - Withdrawal or resignation**

In the event of withdrawal or non-occupation of the exhibition space for any reason whatsoever, the sums paid and/or remaining due in part or in full, in respect of the organization service and ancillary costs, shall be forfeited to the organizer even if another exhibitor comes to benefit from the exhibition space. In the event that an exhibitor, for any reason whatsoever, does not occupy his exhibition space 24 hours before the opening of the Village, he is considered to have resigned.

## **GENERAL REGULATION**

### **Article 5 - Terms of payment**

The payment of the organization service and related costs is made at the times and according to the terms determined by the organizer.

For any late application for participation, the first payment is equal to the amounts already due on the date of the application for participation.

### **Article 6 - Installation and decoration**

The organizer undertakes to make available to the exhibitor the rented stand, installed and set up before the opening date of the event and this until the closing date of the event. For his part, the exhibitor undertakes to take possession of the rented premises which will be indicated to him by the organizer within the time limits which will be specified to him before the beginning of the event. The stands must be impeccably maintained. Packaging and objects that have no connection with the decoration of the stand must be out of sight of visitors. The installation of the exhibition spaces is designed according to the general plan established by the organizer. The organizer determines the affichage procedures, the conditions for the use of all sound, light or audiovisual processes, as well as the conditions under which any promotional operation or animation may be organized within the Village enclosure. The organizer rents and transfers the following services to the exhibitor who accepts them. The rental includes the assembly, maintenance and dismantling of the stand, the right of location, daytime and nighttime security, removal of external waste, and external decoration.

The spaces are delivered empty, the interior decoration is the responsibility of the exhibitor. The interior decoration must be attractive and recall the atmosphere of the event in progress. It is forbidden to drill and screw in the partitions and interior or exterior doors. Any damage will result in penalties. The organization reserves the right to remove or modify any arrangement that would detract from the general aesthetics of the event or disturb neighboring exhibitors or visitors. The exhibitor undertakes to respect the safety standards of the decoration and layout elements. It is strictly forbidden to manipulate the electrical installations made available to exhibitors.

### **Article 7 - Plan and deliveries**

The organizer shall draw up the plan of the Village and effect the allocation of the locations freely, taking into account if possible the wishes expressed by the exhibitor, the nature of the products and/or services he is presenting, the layout of the exhibition space he proposes to install as well as, if necessary, the date of registration of the application to participate. The organizer may modify the size and layout of the areas requested by the exhibitor. Such modification does not entitle the exhibitor to unilaterally terminate his commitment to participate. The location of the exhibition space allocated to an exhibitor is communicated to him by means of a plan. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that the plan is correct before setting up the exhibition space. Each exhibitor is responsible for the transport and receipt of his goods. He is required to comply with the instructions of the organizer concerning the regulation of the entry and exit of goods.

### **Article 8 - Restoration**

The organizer declines all responsibility for constructions or installations erected by the exhibitors.

## **GENERAL REGULATION**

Exhibitors shall take the sites in the condition in which they find them and shall leave them in the same condition. Any damage, in particular to the premises and installations in which the Village is held, caused by an exhibitor or by his installations, materials or goods, shall be charged to this exhibitor.

### **Article 9 - Customs**

It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to complete customs formalities for materials and products coming from abroad. The organizer cannot be held responsible for any difficulty that may arise during these formalities.

### **Article 10 - Insurance Civil**

liability of the organizer Insurance is taken out by the organizer against the pecuniary consequences of its civil liability as organizer. Exhibitors may ask the organizer to send them an insurance certificate specifying the risks covered, the limits of coverage and the period of coverage.

### **Article 11.**

The exhibitor is obliged to take out an insurance policy covering the financial consequences of his civil liability as an exhibitor and, in particular, the liabilities he may incur against all third parties during the entire duration of the Village (including assembly and dismantling). This insurance must be taken out with a company known to be solvent and cover the exhibitor for sufficient amounts. The exhibitor undertakes to communicate this policy to the organizer at the latter's first request.



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
